Southwest Region Update - September 11, 1998

ISSUES:

- Englishman Aggregates Ltd. have submitted their formal application for the proposed Block 579 gravel pit to the VIMDRC for review. It is anticipated that the project review committee will be established by the end of September, with initial meetings and public consultations planned in mid-October.
- Serious concerns related to potentially acid generating coarse coal refuse have been identified at the Quinsam coal mine. Reclamation staff are developing a management strategy and monitoring program to follow-up with Quinsam personnel.
- The controversial North Parkhurst permit was issued to Whistler North Developments in mid-August; to date the regional office has not received the anticipated backlash from the Municipality of Whistler.
- The Mayor of Abbotsford has again complained to the Ministry about the issuance of quarry permits in the Sumas Mountain area. In the meantime, Toews Bros. have been given approval to quarry rock from within a road easement on the Western Rock Quarry, which is exempt from the City's soil removal bylaw.
- Concerns have been filed by the public and the Fraser Valley Regional District regarding Steelhead
 Aggregate's Lake Errock quarry operation, and a proposed major expansion of the quarry. A. Ludwig will
 meet with the company next week to arrange for public meetings.
- A public complaint has been filed regarding expansion of the Allard Contractors Ltd. gravel pit in Mission.
 Regional staff are scheduled to attend a public meeting in mid-October to address public and local government concerns.

FYI:

Continental Lime is constructing road on the Vamey Bay property in preparation for a 6,000 metre drill program to be carried out this winter. The company is proceeding with baseline environmental work, First Nations consultation and feasibility studies for a proposed 250,000 tpy limestone quarry.
