### GLOBAL TO COMMENCE DIAMOND DRILLING ON B.C. GOLD CLAIMS

Global Focus Resources Ltd. is pleased to announce that it is proceeding to commence an exploration program on the mineral claims acquired from Eagle Creek Mining Corporation Inc. The claims are made up of a 25% interest in 36 mineral claims comprising of the White Claims, and the MRS claims located in the Kootenay region of British Columbia (**press release May 14, 1996**).

The acquisition is complete and considered to be a strategic move in the land grab that is currently underway in the area. The claims are immediately adjacent to other claims that contain the **Kenville Mine**. The **Teck Corporation (TEK.T)** and **Anglo Swiss Industries Inc. (ASWC.OTC)** traded at recent highs upon the announcement of further drilling to commence later this summer (May 22, 1996).

**In a dramatic maneuver** Global Focus has not only secured immediate access to drilling equipment, but has already commenced drilling on what it considers to be a fairly large anomaly close to the Kenville Mine. Grab samples and drilling result on six holes (500-600 feet) is expected to be promising as the visible anomaly and historic records clearly list "two types of mineralized structures in the immediate area of the White. The **Gold bearing Quartz** veins that accounted for most of the historical production usually dipped east. **The westerly dipping shear zones were found within the last ten to fifteen years through the use of IP surveys**. At this time, the shears that have been drilled and or exposed along the road cuts also appear to be **Copper/Gold bearing** structures. So far there doesn't appear to have been any production from these westerly dipping zones, but **they appear to have large tonnage and low grade potential**." says John L. Knox GEO.

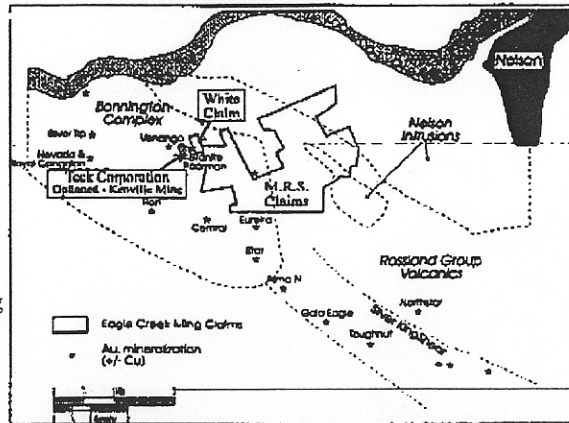

### BC GOLD MINERAL CLAIMS ACQUIRED

Global Focus Resources Ltd. is pleased to announce that subject to regulatory approval, it has entered into an agreement to acquire from Eagle Creek Mining Corporation Inc., a 25% interest in 36 mineral claims comprising of the White claims, and the MRS claims in the Kootenay region, BC.

The acquisition is in consideration of the issuance of 25,000 shares of the company and a commitment to incur 25% of a proposed exploration program to commence at the end of this month. The company will retain its 25% interest based on a proportionate contribution for future exploration programs.

The White claims are immediately adjacent to other claims that contains the Kenville Mine. Teck, in 1995, entered into an agreement to earn a 70% interest in the adjacent properties by spending \$800,000 over four years. In 1996 Teck is planning a program consisting of ground radiometrics, L.P., Mag, VLF-EM and conventional soil sampling. Certain areas of the 1995 I.P. survey are slated for diamond drilling during the 1996 year.



#### THE WHITE CLAIMS

The White mineral claims are located five miles southwest of Nelson on the north face of Morning Mountain. This area has produced gold, silver, and base metals from the late 1800's to the middle of this century. The mineral claims includes a currently inactive gold mine. This mine, along with the neighbouring Kenville mine has produced 63,000 ounces of gold valued today at \$25,000,000.

The White mine contains the Granite Vein and the Greenhorn Vein, two of the five main veins in the area. The Granite Vein has averaged 0.39 oz/ton, and includes areas of the vein which have produced as high as 2.18 oz/ton ore. The Greenhorn Vein which is present in the current mine was reported to produce an average ore grade of 0.58 oz/ton in 1911. This vein was opened from a depth of 150 feet, a shoot of 300 feet and the average thickness was three feet. The vein structure in the area vary in thickness from about an inch to more than six feet and from 500 to 2,500 feet in length.

#### MRS CLAIMS

The MRS claims make up the remaining portion of the project area. These claims are 1.8 miles to the east and one mile to the south of the White Claims. The first target area is a low grade porphyry copper deposit. A 100 foot outcrop section has abundant evidence of copper with showings of chalcopyrite and malachite. Grab samples had assay results of 3% to 6% copper. The second target area is a shear zone with related sulphide mineralization. Within this zone, grab samples with abundant needle like crystals of tourmaline were taken. The presence of tourmaline is a good indicator of the presence of gold.

The company intends to commence an exploration program on these properties within the next 30 days.
