GSC OPEN FILE MAPS 432, 464

The Dorothy vein occurs in the Broadview Formation of the Lardeau Group (Lower Cambrian to Middle Devonian).

The major mines are fault controlled and in this case are on the Cup Creek fault as shown in red on Map 432. This is especially important for prospecting.

3. Plans of Granges for 1987 - from Pat J. DeVeaux, Chief Geologist

Last year they drilled 61 holes for a total footage of 20,231 ft. This year they plan to drill at least 15,000 ft.

Three veins were found.

1. Main Zone 350 m (1147 ft.), 120 m (394' ft.) North + 100 m (348 ft.) South.

Diamond drill indicated ore 200,000 @ 0.3 oz. Au/T.  
This estimate is by Gerald Ryzner, P.Eng. of  
Windflower Mining Ltd.

2. East Zone

Drilled for 150 m (492 ft.) ddh 42, 32.2 gm Au over  
7.77 m (25 ft.).

3. West Zone

Drilled for 60 m (197 ft.) sulphide rich.

A feasibility study is in progress and underground exploration may take place on the Dorothy vein.

Diamond drilling this summer will also include exploration of the old Goldfinch Mine.

An option has been obtained on the Lucky Strike ground from A. Matovich. This includes:
