Notwithstanding the post-decision haze on Tat's, there are few roles and responsibilities which need to be sorted out regarding mineral tenures in this area.

This is what we know so far:

Our Minister indicated to Harcourt and Cashore (Reported by Derek Thompson) that EMPR would take the lead regarding compensation action. Wrong. Authority for negotiations and expropriation is under the Park Act. EMPR can assist by issuing time extensions and providing technical support to the negotiations only.

Our only action at this point is to direct traffic toward whoever

will own the compensation process, provide a time extension to claim holders and provide technical assistance whenever asked.
