- Best gold values in alt'd gns or contact with serpentinites  
1986 metallurgical test = 95% rec. of Au

~~Drill~~ zone = 2750 (length) m x 190m (depth)  
x 4-8m wide

Homestake + Canova Res. have spent  
\$2.5 M + outlined a geological  
resource of ~ 25,000 oz gold.

Problem with tracing min. to depth

Airborne geophys. has traced Yellowstone  
structural zone for 5 km along Pine  
(only 10% tested by drilling)  
- cross structures may be important

1902 - 48 ft. shaft - very high  
grade vein. - later deepened to 85'  
→ 5-stamp mill operated for few yrs.  
but ceased in 1904 due to litigation
