



Willoughby Creek - 1994 drilling on 11 zones at the head of Willoughby Glacier yielded several intersections grading up to 1.17 opt Au and 3.2 opt Ag over 11.7 metres.

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Willoughby. Looking westerly towards the North zone (above) and at the blasted bench and portal area (right). Approximately 50 m of an intended 100 m long adit was driven in 1995. A 27-hole, 3000 m surface diamond drill program was also completed. Exploration in 1996 will comprise underground drill testing of the North zone, at 20 - 25 m stations and, if results warrant, completion of the adit. Additional surface work will also be conducted.
