follow it down. Vein looks about 4' wide.

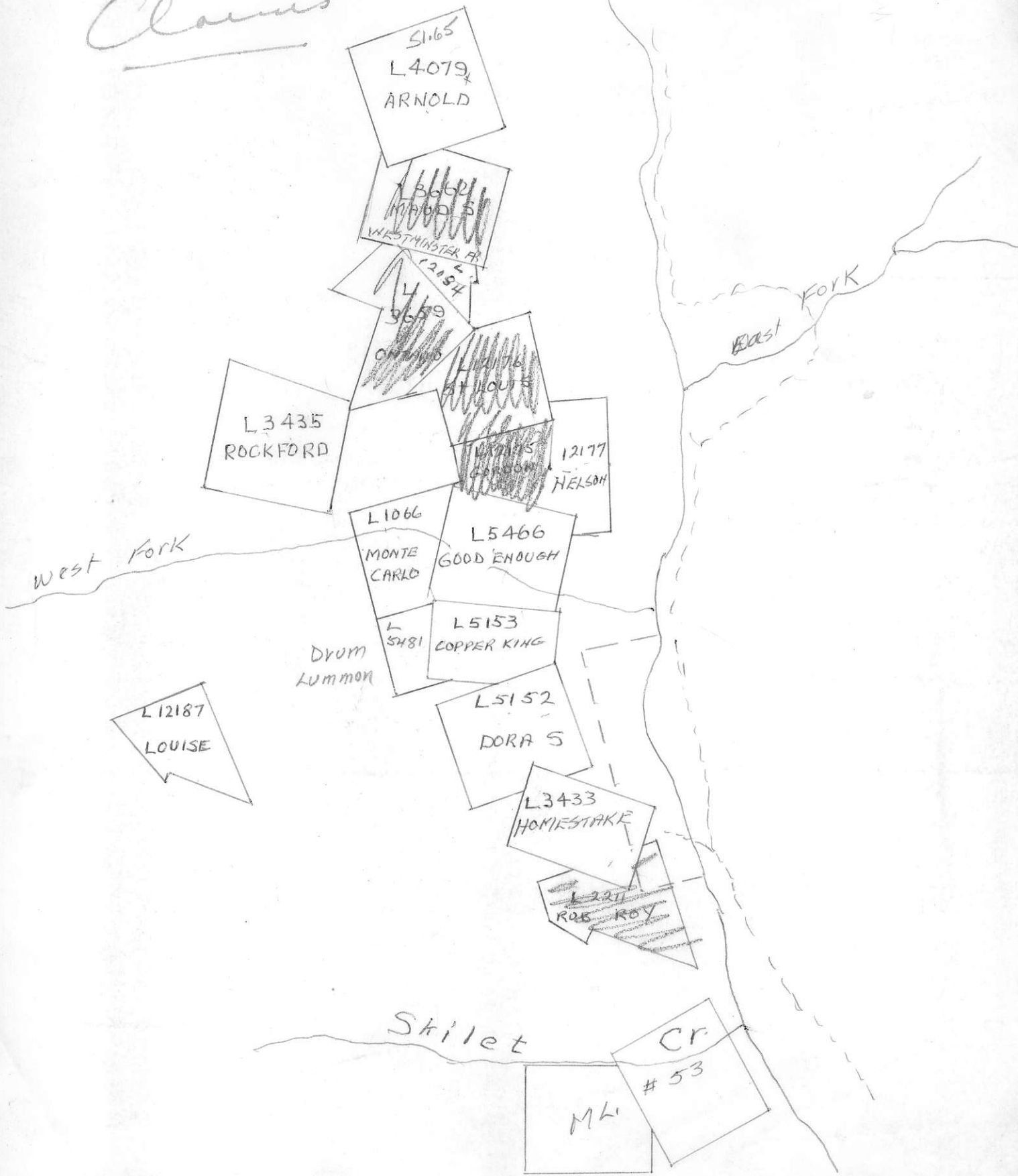
It looks like this kept addit as wide as vein

1927-313 - Arnold & St Louis - Near Green city, which
is about 6 miles from Eric, C.M. & S. had 2 diamond
drills working all summer on the Arnold, owned
by W Connolly and on the St Louis, reported to be
owned by Mrs McAvoy & C Green.

The mineralization in this section is
mostly iron and copper sulphides occurring in
rocks of the Rosland volcanic series. The drilling
outfits were taken out for the winter.

1896-75 - At the Arnold, a shaft 25 ft deep, has been
sunk through altered and silicified porphyries,
carrying galena, pyrite, blende and chalcopyrite:
the lead is not well defined.
