PROGRESS REPORT

DURING THE WEEK OF NOV 4-11 1983 L. SOSTAD ALONG WITH TWO PROSPECTORS EXAMINED THE KETTLE GROUP FOR PETROQUIN RESOURCES LTD. THE CLAIMS ARE MADE UP OF THE GO #1&2 (2 UNITS), KETTLE #3 (15 UNITS) AND 5 REVERTED CROWN GRANTS (MAYFLOWER, LILLIE MAY, 7:30, SUPERIOR & JEWEL).

THE KETTLE GROUP LIES ON THE WESTERN FLANK OF THE CHRISTIAN VALLEY APPROX. 34 KM NORTH FROM WESTBRIDGE B.C.

TRAVERSES WERE MADE THROUGHOUT THE CLAIM GROUP. IT WAS FELT THAT THE AREA WHERE REVERTED CROWN GRANTS ARE SHOULD BE MORE CLOSELY EXAMINED.

PYRITE AND OR PYROTITE WERE FOUND (VERY FINELY DISSEMINATED) ON THE EASTERN PART OF THE CLAIM GROUP ON WHICH THE MAYFLOWER AND THE LILLIE MAY REVERTED CROWN GRANTS LIE. NO OLD WORKING WERE EVIDENT. THE 7:30 REV. CROWN GRANT WHICH IS NOT CONTIGUOUS WITH THE KETTLE GROUP WAS TRAVERSED VIA WASMES CREEK. NO EVIDENCE OF MINERALIZATION WAS FOUND. THERE IS AN OLD TRAIL (ROAD?) THAT GOES UP WASMES CREEK FROM THE VALLEY BOTTOM.

THE MOST SIGNIFIGANT AREA AT THIS TIME APPEARS TO BE THE N.W. PORTION OF THE CLAIMS, NAMELY THE JEWEL AND SUPERIOR REVERTED CROWN GRANTS. THIS AREA HAS NUMEROUS SHALLOW SHAFTS (+ OR - 20 FEET), SHORT ADITS (UP TO 20 FT. AND MANY SMALL BLASTED TRENCHES. DUE TO SNOW WE COULD ONLY MAKE A VERY CURSORY EXAMINATION.

A NORTH SOUTH BASELINE SHOULD BE CUT THROUGH THE CENTRE OF THE JEWEL AND SUPERIOR REV. CROWN GRANTS. ALL THE OLD WORKINGS COULD BE THEN TIED INTO THE BASELINE (AND PROPERLY SAMPLED). THE SOUTHEAST PORTION OF THE CLAIM AREA COULD BE MORE CLOSELY EXAMINED (MAYFLOWER AND LILLIE MAY). NOTHING SIGNIFIGANT WAS FOUND ON THE 7:30 REV. CROWN GRANT.

THE GO #3 2-POST CLAIM WAS STAKED NOV8 AND RECORDED DEC 1 1983. THIS WAS DONE IN ORDER TO MAKE THE GO #1&2 CONTIGUOUS WITH THE KETTLE #3 CLAIM FOR FILLING OF ASSESSMENT WORK.

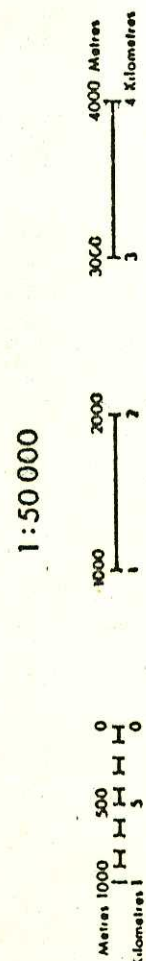

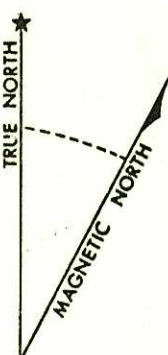

Annual change decreasing

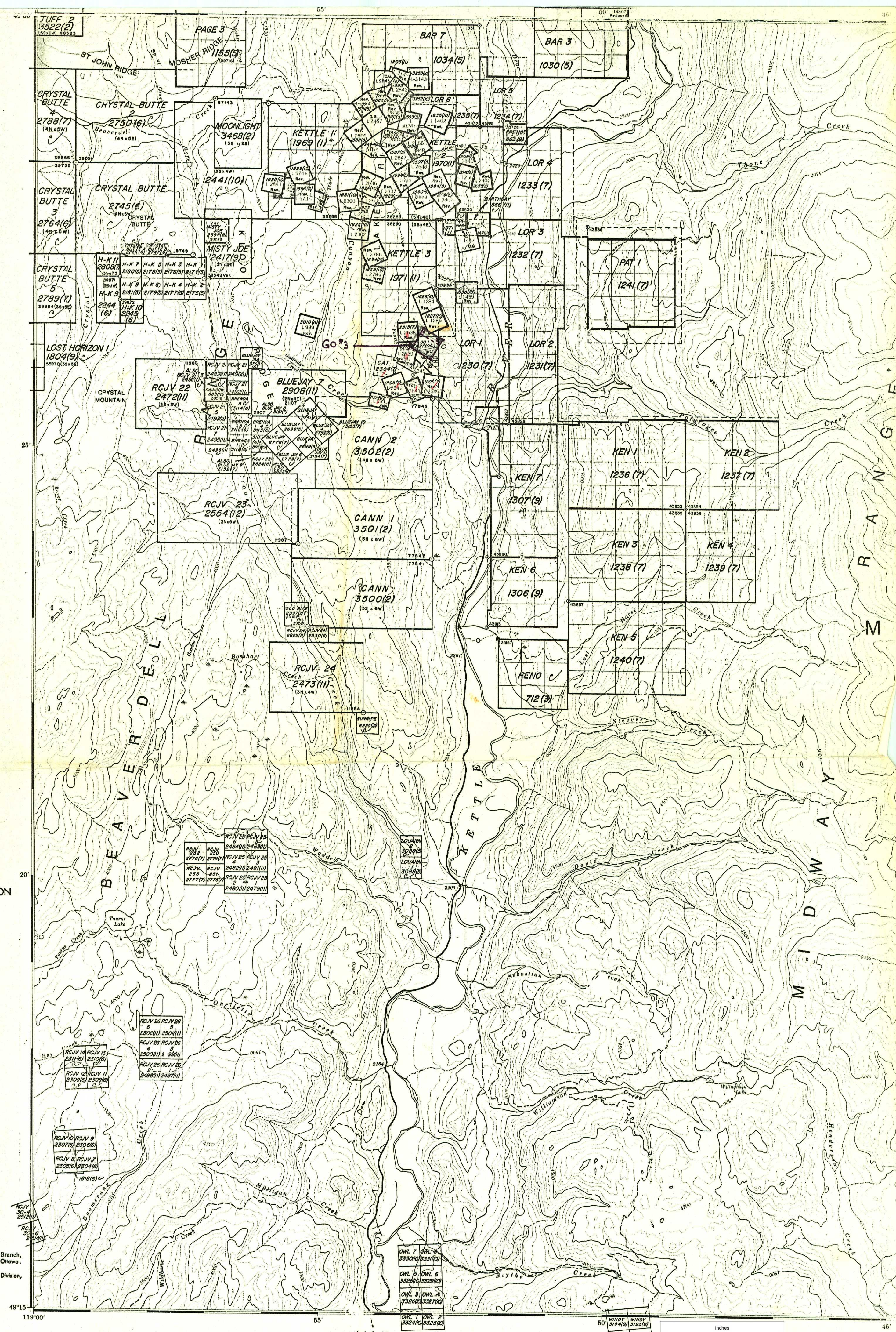

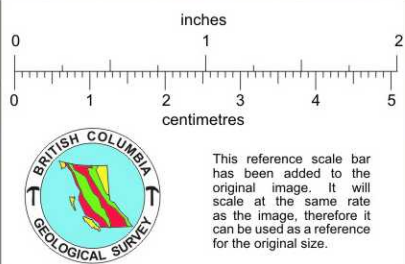
