rict. An open-ended zone of copper mineralization was drill inferred by previous workers. Zappa's drilling program consisting of 6 angle holes, spaced 160 ft. apart, tested the copper zone along a length of 850 ft. & to a depth of 330 ft. Drill hole assays are summarized above.

The average grade as indicated by the 13 previous diamond drill holes combined with the recent 1992 six reverse circulation holes now averages 0.59 % copper.

The drilling program confirmed thickness and grade of the copper zone along a portion of the 2,700 foot long target. An I.P. anomaly southeast of the presently drilled area is the prime target for continued drilling.

Metallurgical test work will now begin in order to determine amenability of leach processing.
