LA ROCK MINING CORP. (LAR-V)

ZONE EXTENDED - David L. Simms, secretary, La Rock Mining Corp., reports drill holes 92-57 and 92-58 have extended the mineralized dacite tuff horizon 300 feet south of the original Tedi Pit massive sulphide showing on the Brandywine project 30 miles north of Squamish, B.C. Hole 58 will be completed this month; it encountered drilling problems at the mineralized horizon. Hole 57, drilled vertically, shows an increase in grade with depth in the dacite horizon as follows: 0.18% copper, 3.21% lead, 3.54% zinc, 1.02 oz.silver/ton and 0.01 oz.gold/ton from 65 to 90 feet. Mineral showings have been found over an area of 500 by 1,000 feet. If the horizontal dacite tuff model can continue to be confirmed by diamond drilling, the potential for the Tedi Pit area could be several million tons accessible by shallow open pit.
