TO BE EXPLORED AT BRALORNE X-Cal Resources Ltd. has
received a report on the
Pilot gold project, Bralorne/Goldbridge, 100 miles north
of Vancouver, B.C., from Cogema Canada. Subject to a
10% net profit interest in the property to be retained
by X-Cal, Cogema can earn 100% of the property by making
payments totalling \$260,000 to X-Cal and carrying out
work. Results to date show the Pilot property could
host bulk-tonnage porphyry-style gold/copper minerali-
zation. Further work is recommended.
Surface sampling has shown a 10-metre width grading
4 grams per ton gold (0.14 oz/t) and 0.12% copper. Grab
samples in three locations returned over 100 grams

gold/t (+3 oz per ton) and 3% copper. Coarse visible gold has also been observed near one of the high grade locations. Only one hole has been drilled on the property which was mineralized over an 84-metre length and contained a 10.5-metre section grading 1 gram gold/t and 0.16% copper. The gold/copper mineralization has been observed over an area of about 700 metres by 400 metres within a granodiorite host. Numerous surface samples averaging 0.01 oz.gold/t were taken in this area. The report recommends drilling and further investigation of the whole contact zone of the granodiorite with the Bridge River cherts over 1.5 km.
