GRAPHITE PROJECT UPDATE - Paul Schiller, president, reports

I.M.P. Industrial Mineral Park Mining Corp. has completed a survey and mapping of the 50% owned/50% optioned Black Crystal graphite property at 6,000 to 7,000 ft. elevation near the headwaters of Hoder Creek, Slocan, West Kootenay, southeast BC. Two highgrade zone were identified. Zone No.1 was surveyed and geologically mapped over dimensions: ZONE 1- STRIKE 4,400 FEET. DOWN SLOPE DEPTH 1,300 FEET, TRUE WIDTH 250 FEET.

A bulk sample of 800 pounds was taken from No.1 deposit for metallurgical testing and grade determination by an independent laboratory. A composite sample was taken over 2,000 feet of strike length. The sample is representative of the decomposed surface of the graphite deposit.

The geologist is in the process of completing reports, structural maps and graphite reserves. Two highgrade zones have been identified. Host rock type consists of greenschist facies graphite, biotite schist, dark green to light green colour, weathered brown due to oxidation of biotite, and lower grade graphite marble. This metasedimentary package is hosted concordantly within amphibolite grade graphite gneiss. (SEE GCNL NO.209, 30Oct98, P.8 FOR FINANCING INFORMATION)

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
