YAHK PROJECT DRILLING COMPLETED - Richard W. Hughes,
president, Abitibi

Mining Corp., reports the planned 1998 drilling program for the 100% owned Yahk property 30 km south of Kimberley, southeast BC has been completed. Three holes were drilled totalling 998 feet. All three holes encountered mineralization near a structural intersection believed to be the site of a vent system for Sullivan type lead, zinc mineralization.

Hole No.1 (Y-98-1) was drilled to a depth of 500 feet and between 65-135 feet intercepted a zone of fractured and altered Aldridge sediments with lesser zones of galena, sphalerite and pyrrhotite fracture filling. The chloritic, pyritic, sericitic, quartz alteration appears to cross cut bedding.

Hole No.2 (Y-98-2), located about 250 feet north of Y-98-2, was drilled to a depth of 250 feet and showed a similar alteration from top to bottom with minor base metal zones.

Hole No.3 (Y-98-3) was drilled about 100 feet south of Y-98-01 and intercepted a similar type and grade of mineralization and alteration as Y-98-1.

As a result of the complex interpretation of the alteration, structure and mineralization, detailed laboratory analyses of drill core (type, grade and extent of mineralization) are expected to be completed by the end of November, 1998.

Subsequent of completion drilling, the company staked 8 contiguous claim units covering adjoining geologic formations prospective for Sullivan-type mineralization. (SEE GCNL NO.214, 6Nov-98, P.2 FOR CLAIR WEST PROJECT INFORMATION)

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
