

LIGHTNING CREEK MINES LTD. (LCB-V)

* EXPLORATION PROJECTS REVIEWED - John Dupuy, president of Lightning Creek Mines Ltd., reports that exploration has started on the Northern Gold project, a joint venture of Lightning Creek, Dia Met Minerals Ltd. and Chevron Minerals Ltd. On 10Jun87, Chevron, the operator, moved a camp into Tattamania Lake about 100 miles west of Dasse Lake in NW B.C. Two diamond drills will follow a week later. Drilling will start on the Misty-Nie claim block and the Outlaw claims. The Misty-Nie block covers the northern extension of the West Wall Fault which hosts the Bear deposit to the south. North American Metals Corp. recently announced overall geological reserves of 1,522,100 tons grading 0.31 oz. gold/ton in the Bear deposit which is being explored by a joint venture of North American and Chevron. A two phase program is recommended.

has bought 6 placer leases from Cottonwood Resources Ltd. by issue of 37,500 common shares. The 2.5 kilometer property lies between the Last Chance, Grub Gulch and Van Winkle Creeks. Recorded production for these 3 tributaries of Lightning Creek is 41,100 ounces of gold from 1874 to 1945.

Lightning Creek Mines also holds 33 placer leases and nine 20-unit mineral claims covering much of the Upper Lightning Creek drainage system. Exploration comprising geophysics, geology and drilling will start next week.

Concerning the joint venture Birch Point property of Lightning Creek and Tanqueray Resources in the Dryden area of Ontario, the partners staked 9 more claims to cover the extension of the mineralized zone indicated by a government geophysical survey. The property now comprises 17 claims. Lightning Creek plans to spend \$125,000 on geochemistry, geology, geophysics and diamond drilling before 28Feb88.

An agreement is being completed with F.C. and Exploration for a private placement to raise \$350,000. The company is also negotiating with other groups to provide additional funds.

LOGAN MINES LTD. (LOG-V)

WORK RESUMES ON GOLD - Logan Mines Ltd. and joint CLAIMS NEAR OSOYOOS venturer Tinto Gold Corp. started work on the L.G. claims northeast of Osoyoos on 17Jun87. It is planned to test, by electromagnetic survey and trenching, the structure uncovered last fall in order to establish drill targets for the next phase of this year's program. Samples from last year's encouraging exploration assayed 0.310 oz. of gold per ton across 10 feet and one 6-inch wide vein assayed 4.94 oz. gold/t.

CELEBRITY ENERGY CORP. (CEC-V)

WORK STARTING ON - Paul Frigstad, president of Celebrity ADAMS LAKE CLAIMS Energy Corp., reports that a geological crew is now on Celebrity's JC claims in the Adams Lake area, B.C. The claims adjoin the west border of those of Rea Gold/Falconbridge Copper (Minnova) shown on the map in GCNL 115(87) overleaf page 1.

The crew will assess geochemical and geophysical anomalies previously located on Celebrity's ground preparatory to a follow-up trenching program, which, in turn, is expected to be followed by diamond drilling.

POLESTAR EXPLORATION INC. (PSE-V)

MANITOBA ANOMALIES - Polestar Exploration Inc. has TO BE TESTED concluded an agreement with ALAMADEN RESOURCES CORPORATION of the Falcon Lake property in southeast Manitoba, along the Trans Canada Highway.

An airborne magnetic and electromagnetic survey conducted in early 1987 identified numerous strong coincident magnetometer and electromagnetic anomalies of which 18 are classified as high priority.

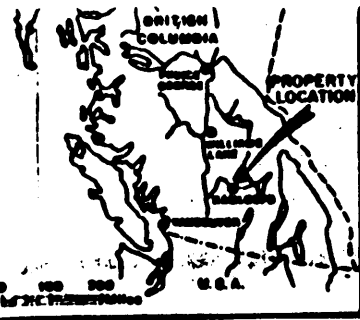
Regional exploration by SELCO in 1962 for massive sulphide deposits resulted in 3 diamond drill holes on the property. Two of these holes intersected some 20 feet of siliceous sedimentary iron formation containing impressive intersections of massive and disseminated pyrite, pyrrhotite and magnetite.

Selco only assayed 3 random sections of core with massive sulphides which ran .01, .01 and .03 oz./to gold. No drill core is available for re-assay.

The two drill holes occur in only one of the high priority geophysical targets described above.

Polestar has arranged \$500,000 of flow-through financing with NIM Resource 1987 and Company for an intensive exploration program to start immediately.

Polestar can earn up to 50% interest by spending \$1,600,000 by March 15, 1991, including a \$80,000 payment to reimburse Almaden for airborne geophysical surveys to date.
