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## GITENNES EXPLORATION INC.

FOX PROJECT UPDATE - Jerry Blackwell, president, reports
Gitennes Explorations Inc. is

consolidating its land position surrounding the recently 100% optioned (subject to 1.25% NSR) property near Merritt in southern BC. The expanded property currently covers an area of 65 square km.

The Fox property encompasses a recently discovered showing of polymetalic massive sulphide mineralization hosted by intermediate to felsic volcanic rocks. The showing is partially exposed in a road-cut, being largely covered by surface debits. It has been traced in outcrop, bedrock rubble and float over a cross-sectional area 100 metres long that is from 2 to 4 metres thick. Both ends of the zone are covered by overburden, and the base is not exposed. Grab sample results from mineralized outcrops are:

The mineralized zone is characterized by quartz sericite schist (15289), pyrite, sphalerite, chert rock (15290), and barite, sphalerite, cemented felsic breccia (15284 & 15286). Associated minerals include chalcopyrite, galena and tetrahedrite. Throughout the length of the zone, scattered higher grade boulders of dense massive sulphide rock occur, but have yet to be found in outcrop. Two boulders were submitted for assay:

The geology and strong mineralization would suggest an important, new exploration target exists. In addition to staking, Gitennes is doing a program of geological mapping, prospecting and rock sampling, to be followed by geophysical survey of portions of the property.

Access to the property is by a major provincial highway and an extensive network of logging roads. Two power transmission lines cross the property, one of which goes to the Highland Valley Mine. A number of producing and closed copper mines are found within a 45-minute drive of the Fox property, including Highland Valley, Craigmont, and Afton amongst others.
