PRINCETON DRILLING TO RESUME - James McLeod, P.Geo.,
president, Nustar

Resources Inc., and 50/50 joint venture partner Frontier Minerals Inc. reports drilling will resume immediately on their Miner Mountain property near Princeton in the Similkameen Mining Division, southwest BC. The information from this program will be used to farther determine the possible size and grade potential of the property. This will be accomplished by fill-in dulling in the area between the 1997 and beyond (east of) the 1974-3 Bethlehem hole in the Granby-Bethlehem zone. The companies now believe they have determined the general trend of the volcanic units which hosts the mineralization and what remains is to check for continuity between the holes. This Phase II - 2000 program requires three angle holes to be drilled to test a zone with a minimum of 1,000 feet of strike length which has returned anomalous values in copper, gold and platinum group elements. This zone lies within a 3,000 foot long zone with inferred mineral inventories of 500,000 tons of 0.5% copper in the Regal zone on the westside and 600,000 tons of 0.25% to 0.30% copper in the Granby-Bethlehem zone on the eastside.
