SPANISH MOUNTAIN SAMPLING STARTS - J.W. Morton, P.Geo.,  
president, Wildrose  
Resources Ltd., reports Imperial Metals Corp. recently started work  
at the Spanish Mountain property located six km east of the town of  
Likely in the Cariboo Mining Division about 50 km south of Wells,  
central BC. Refer to map overleaf P.1 in GCNL NO.91, 11May2000.

In December 1999, Imperial Metals and Wildrose entered an  
option/joint venture agreement on the Spanish Mountain Cariboo  
property. Under the terms of this agreement, Imperial Metals may  
earn a 75% interest in this property by spending \$500,000 before  
December 2004. Wildrose retains the remaining 25% interest and is  
entitled to an additional payment of \$0.50 per ton mined.

A year 2000 program was subsequently proposed in which five  
bulk samples will be excavated and processed. Each site will be  
prepared by drilling a grid array of blast holes to a depth of 3 metres.  
Cuttings will be collected and assayed before the holes are loaded and  
blasted. Material from each site will then be moved to a central  
crushing facility for crushing sampling and stacking. The five piles  
will, at a later date, be batch processed at the flotation mill facilities  
of Imperial's nearby Mount Polley mine.

Significant previous results from Spanish Mountain include:

- Trench 96-101: 0.085 oz.gold/ton over 105 feet. (2.91 grams/tonne over 32 metres)
- South Trench: 0.095 oz. gold/ton over 49 feet. (3.26 grams/ tonne over 15 metres)
- Trench A: 0.092 oz.gold/ton over 62 feet. (3.15 grams/tonne over 19 metres)
- Drill Hole 88-RCH-112: 0.848 oz.gold/ton over 33 feet (29.07 grams/ tonne over 10 metres)
- Drill Hole MR-7: 0.223 oz.gold/ton over 88 feet. (7.99 grams gold/tonne over 27 metres)

In other news, the option of Phelps Dodge, Canada, Ltd. on the  
Woodjam project near Williams Lake, BC has been terminated, and  
Wildrose has begun reviewing this project with other groups. In  
1999, Phelps Dodge drilled hole 99-20 which returned a 144 metre  
intercept grading 0.72 grams gold/tonne and 0.15% copper in a  
monzonitic subvolcanic breccia. (SEE GCNL NO.91, 11May2000,
