**SABLE RESOURCES LTD.**

TOODOGGONE PROGRAM STARTS - Lynda Mosley, director,  
reports Sable Resources  
Ltd. has mobilized a crew to its 100% owned Chappelle property (at  
the Baker Mine site) in the Toodoggone area of north-central BC and  
is currently readying the camp for the exploration program to start

immediately.

Near the close of the 1999 exploration program, a new vein named Beck vein, was exposed by trenching on the Chappelle property. The vein is five feet wide and has been exposed for about 100 feet. Three diamond drill pads were prepared at the close of last year for immediate drilling at startup.

The results achieved during 1999 have given new insight on five mineralized zones located elsewhere on the 11,000 acre property.

The newly discovered zones have mineralization and structural characteristics with signatures similar to the previously mined A and B veins which hosted 95,000 and 55,000 tons grading 0.9 and 0.65 oz. gold equivalent/ton, respectively. The Beck vein appears to be associated with the same body of rock (altered quartz-feldspar porphyry) generally believed to be the source of vein A.

The program will continue to explore the Ridge Zone for the source of the several float trains of high grade gold and silver quartz as well as the five newly discovered quartz-clay epithermal centres. Geophysical and geochemical surveys, extensive backhoe trenching and follow up diamond drilling are planned. (SEE GCNL NO.198, 15Oct99, P.4 FOR PREVIOUS TOODOGGONE PROJECT INFORMATION)
