IRISHMAN TRENCHING - James McDonald, president, Black ASSAYS RECEIVED Bull Resources Inc., reports trenching conducted by Sedex Mining Corp. on its

Thea 17 mineral claim located on the Irishman property near Upper Kidd Creek, Nelson Mining Division, southeast BC has discovered an auriterous siliceous shear within the Proterozoic Middle Aldridge Formation. The property is situated 35 km southwest of Kimberley

(Sullivan Mine) and 30 km southwest of Crambros. Assays have recently been received and compiled from samples taken during an August trenching program. Trenching exposed the shear in two trenches 30 metres apart. The shear is 2.5 metres wide in the south trench and 4.5 metres wide in the north trench and strikes northwest and measured widths are true widths. Chip samples were taken over 0.5 metre intervals. The shear zone contains sheared, albitized, limonitic quartzite and argillite which is locally silicified and containing pyrite and rare visible gold. In the north trench the average grade was 5,283 ppb gold (0.154 oz/ton) over 4.5 metres and in the south trench the average grade was 3,065 ppb gold (0.089 oz/ton) over 2.5 metres. One sample from the north trench returned 0.56 oz. gold/ton in a fire assay.

Black Bull can earn a 50% interest in the Irishman property from Sedex Mining by spending \$1,000,000 on exploration s over four years. Black Bull can earn an additional 10% interest by completing a bankable feasibility study.

This is a new discovery - further trenching, sampling and drilling are being reviewed for the spring of 2000. This shear zone is very similar to the David shear located 15 km to the north.
