CONSOLIDATION EXPANDS RESOURCES - John H. Kruzick, president, DRC Resources Corp., reports the consolidation of the Afton and Ajax properties under DRC Resources' holdings increases its copper, gold resources in the Afton area near Kamloops, BC. With Afton's estimated underground resources of 10,500,000 tons and 10,000,000 tons open pit, and the addition of the Ajax's potential of over 40,000,000 tons, the project takes on a new dimension. The company continues a strategy of acquiring copper, gold properties in the Afton area to increase its resource base.

DRC has acquired 16 adjoining mineral claims totalling 1,000 acres covering the 700 metre length between the two Ajax' open-pits, where 30,000,000 tons of copper, gold ore was mined and milled at the Afton mill site. From discussions with the previous operator, DRC understands a resource of over 40,000,000 tons remains between the two open-pits. DRC has combined the Python and Ajax mineral claims into one claim group comprising of 77 claim units (4,500 acres), covering a number of mineral zones. The Afton and Ajax properties now increases DRC's land position to 127 claim units for a total of 7,700 acres. DRC intends to explore the copper, gold zone between the Ajax pits to develop additional tonnage while exploring the Afton Mine property.
