[IC-T] 40,580,743 SHS. CROWSNEST DRILLING UPDATE - G.L. Garratt, director, Eastfield Resources Ltd., reports Inter-

national Curator Resources Ltd. has completed a drilling program on the Crowsnest property 50 km southeast of Fernie, southeast BC. Int'l Curator holds an option to earn a 75% interest from Eastfield Resources Ltd. by funding exploration over six years.

A total of 3,597 feet (1,096 m) were completed in 10 holes. The drill program was designed to locate the source of high-grade gold bearing boulders and cobbles. Various anomalies were tested over an area of about 900 by 600 metres.

Analytical results have been received for the first three holes (CP-99-1, 2, 3). No significant gold mineralization was encountered in these holes. Hole CP-99-3, drilled to a depth of 102.4 metres, displayed anomalous gold values over a 46.25 metre (151.5 ft) length with up to 330 ppb in moderately altered syenite intrusions and up to 200 ppb in weakly altered carbonate rocks. The remaining seven holes are being processed and results from these are expected around month end.
