## BOOKER GOLD EXPLORATIONS LTD. [BGE-V] 10,747,729 SHS.

MORRISON PROJECT - J. Paul Stevenson, CEO, reports Booker EXPL'N REVIEW Gold Explorations Ltd., in its role as an exploration model for the recent First Nations-Mineral Sector Workshop at Granisle, BC, completed one vertical diamond drill hole to a depth of 310 metres (1,018 feet) and 720 metres of trenching on the Morrison deposit 65 km northeast of Smithers in the Babine Lake area of central BC, under a 50% option from NORANDA INC. [NOR-V, T, M]. The purpose of the drill hole was to ascertain vertical continuity of mineralization intersected at depth by diamond drill hole Mo-98-2, (46 metres of 0.8% copper, 0.48 grams gold/tonne, 2.27 grams silver/tonne), type of mineralization and fracture analysis to depth. Diamond drill hole Mo 99-4 was collared 80 metres east of diamond drill hole Mo-98-3 and is extensively mineralized with disseminated chalcopyrite and bornite, bottoming in mineralization. The hole successfully extended the target zone and indicates vertical or near vertical structures. The trenching program enabled Booker's geologists to sample and conduct detailed mapping. Noranda's trenches in the area were trenched in the 1960s by bulldozer but never assayed. Booker retrenched and extended trenching using an excavator. Assays are pending.

Booker Gold continues to work with members of the mining industry and First Nations with a goal to bring certainty and investor confidence to BC.
