ANOTHER SIGNIFICANT HOLE - Drilling on the Brett claims
DRILLED ON GOLD CLAIMS 25 km west of Vernon, B.C.,
 has encountered additional
 mineralization. Stirling D. McIlveen, president of
 Huntington Resources Inc., says the latest results are
 from DDH 87-42 located 965 feet south of the discovery
 holes, DDH 87-29 and DDH 87-30.

This intersection, together with intersections in
 earlier drill holes, is associated with a steeply
 dipping mineralized shear structure traced over a length
 of 1900 feet. It is significant that this intersection
 is situated on section 425 feet lower than the high
 grade intersection reported in discovery hole DDH 87-29.
 (See GCNL 201(87) P.2 for results of Holes 87-29 through
 37 and for detail of interests Lacana Mining Corp. can
 earn by funding work on this project.)

Mr. McIlveen says drilling is continuing along the
 shear structure. Further results will be made available
 following analysis by representatives of both Huntington
 and Lacana.
