----- committed to spend \$150,000 in 1987 on the Windpass property and has thus far spent over \$350,000. The intercept in Hole 7 is interesting in that it is a chloritic shear rather than a vein. The widest zone is 0.05 ozs/ton over 15.6 feet in Hole 1. It's low grade but may indicate the downward extension of the Windpass ore zone. Geologists on the property reported that a 50 foot intersection on the one hole still not reported looked "very interesting".
