NEW TONNAGE - Westmin Resources Limited and ESTIMATES REPORTED Canacord Resources Inc. are exploring the Big Missouri property under an option from Tournigan Mining Explorations Ltd. and the Silbak Premier property, a 50:50 joint venture with Silbak Premier Mines Limited, both located near Stewart, B.C.

The 1987 drilling on the Big Missouri property is complete with 23,922 feet drilled in 92 holes, mainly within the S-1 and Martha Ellen zones. Results of the first 67 holes indicate an expansion of the S-1 and Martha Ellen zones. A significant expansion of mineable reserves is anticipated from the previously reported 1,745,800 tons grading 0.105 oz. gold/t and 0.86 oz. silver/t, or a gold equivalent of 0.117 oz/t based on a 1:70 gold/silver ratio. Re-estimation of geological and mineable reserves is in progress.

The first phase of drilling earlier this summer in the Glory Hole area at Silbak Premier increased geological reserves from 6,348,431 tons grading 0.066 oz. gold/t and 2.70 oz. silver/t to 7,003,540 tons grading 0.068 oz. gold/t and 2.59 oz. silver/t. Tonnage and grade of mineable reserves has not been re-estimated but is expected to be largely unchanged from the previous estimate of 6,468,759 tons grading (0.063 oz. gold/t) and 2.34 oz. silver/t for a gold equivalent of 0.096 oz. per ton.

Westmin's exploration manager Harlan Meade reports that the second phase of drilling has begun at Silbak Premier with approximately 15,000 feet of drilling planned in the Glory Hole area and in the Power and Hope zones. Drilling in the Glory Hole area is both to fill in gaps between previously drilled holes and to further test the down-dip extension of the West and Main zones. The Power and Hope zones are the extension of the West zone and the near surface expression of the mineralization is being tested for open pit potential.

DRILL CUTS SULPHIDE A drill is operating on the Crown Grants prospect of Bighorn Development Corporation in the Sulphurets Creek area of NW B.C., some 55 miles north of Stewart. To date, two holes totalling 736 feet have been completed. Both cut extensive sulphide. Assay results are expected by mid-November.

These 2 holes and a third, now drilling, are in a 3-hole vertical fan (-45, -60 and -70 degrees) beneath an old adit. President J.E. Wyder Ph.D., P.Eng., has presented assays of surface chip samples.

When the first 3 holes are completed, the drill will be swung so as to intersect the mineralized structure 50 to 100 feet to the south.

The drill site is on a very steep slope about 100 feet west of the steep, westerly dipping target zone.
