SILVER-GOLD ASSAYS REPORTED - Charles N.O'Sullivan,

Resources Ltd., reports that the 1500-foot decline has now been completed at the Skylark/O.B. mine at Greenwood, B.C. Development of this gold/silver deposit is a 50-50 joint venture with Skylark Resources Ltd. Samples of the H Zone vein taken from two 40-foot crosscuts off the decline at the 300-foot level, returned the average values shown in the table. A picked sample from the south face of No.4 crosscut assayed 1,137.5 oz.silver and 0.986 oz.gold/t.

Underground exploration of the Serp gold zone has been initiated by driving a drift from the decline. The Serp zone had been intersected by surface drill hole 13 which assayed 0.431 oz.gold/t over 13.5 feet. The exploratory drift has now reached the Serp zone and
