River district, some 60 miles NW of Stewart, B.C. President R.E. Davis reports that a high grade zone previously indicated by sampling at the drift level has swelled into a substantial ore shoot. Chip sample results across the true width of the vein at the 1129 Elevation Lift are shown in the table above. The ore shoot averages 1.73 ounces gold per ton across an average true width of 8.7 feet for a total strike length of 46 feet at the 1129 Lift level.

Mr. Davis says the first blast at the 1132 Elevation Lift shows the ore shoot to be swelling even more. Chip and test hole samples were taken from the hanging wall and one from the foot wall across the true width of the vein at survey station 181 + 3m.E with the results shown in the table below.

## DRAGON RESOURCES LTD. (DGM-V)

HIGH GRADE HOLE DRILLED - Walter J. Clemens, a director of Dragoon Resources, reports that a hole drilled to intersect the ninth level at the Comstock mine in SE B.C., owned 50-50 by Dragoon and GREENSTONE RESOURCES LTD. (GRE-T,M), assayed 155.04 oz. silver/t, 5.35% lead, 1.24% lead and 0.03 oz. gold/t. Over a normal mining width, the silver grade would fall back to about 100 oz. silver/t. Mr. Clemens says this intersection is 260 feet from the current point of the advance in the ninth level drift. Several more holes are planned and cross cutting to the new zone has started. Production testing continues at the Ainsworth mill with satisfactory results. The first shipment of concentrates is planned for later this month.

## CEDARMIN RESOURCES LTD. (CDM-Alberta)

GOLD DISCOVERED - Cedarmin Resources reports that a ON CARIBOO CLAIMS gold discovery has been made on their property south of Barkerville near Likely in the Cariboo district, B.C. A shallow diamond drill hole on the Dave Group claims intersected 2.5 feet assaying 0.16 oz. gold/t. Three anomalous zones were tested by reverse circulation drilling but no economic values were detected.

Cedarmin has acquired 100% interest in the Top and Treasure mineral claims covering 2100 acres near Terrace, B.C.. Terms were not disclosed.

MOUNT ALLARD RESOURCES LTD. (MTQ-V) has started 3,000 feet of diamond drilling along with trenching and field work on the company's gold and platinum prospect on Gun Creek in the Goldbridge-Bralorne area, SW B.C.

CATEAR RESOURCES LTD. (CAA.A-V) has advanced the decline on the Goldwedge property near Stewart, B.C. a total of 860 feet from the portal and is expected to intersect the Golden Rocket vein for the second time at 910 feet. The vein will then be drifted along and a raise and manway driven to the glory hole on surface. This work is designed to up-grade some of the 291,916 tons averaging 0.837 oz.gold/t, 2.56 oz.silver/t to the proven class. At the same time a 10,000 to 15,000 foot drill program is planned to add indicated reserves. Construction of the mill is progressing with tune up of the plant expected to start in mid-May. An 80 ton fine ore bin has been constructed with work progressing on the desiter tables, mill alignment, conveyor belts, electrical wiring and grizzly set-up.

Catear Resources has entered a letter of intent to acquire the East Gold property in the Sulphurets area, north of Stewart, B.C.
