Eight diamond drill holes have been completed with copper sulphides present over long intersections in all drill holes; hole 89-6 contains a 39 foot section with occurrences of native copper. Assay results are awaited. The drill has been moved 1150 feet to the north to test an anomaly on the adjacent Tedray property and to enable Sulphurets to complete their earn-in on a 50% interest.
