## HAWKEYE DEVELOPMENTS LTD. (HAD-V)

EXPLORATION PLANS - Joe Whipple, president, reports Hawk-  
FOR LOMOND CLAIMS eye Developments Ltd. has acquired  
14 claims and staked five more, 50  
km. SE of Trail, B.C. known as the Lomond property.  
Nine claims were acquired for \$300 each plus \$1,000 per  
claim if they are drilled and \$10,000 worth of shares if  
production is achieved. The other five claims were  
acquired for a 1.5% net smelter return. The claims form  
the area referred to as the International Lead and Zinc  
lines, adjacent to the Canada/U.S. border. Fifteen  
claims were also staked on the U.S. side immediately  
adjacent to the Lomond property.

Mineralization on the claims consists of galena and  
sphalerite disseminated in cherty dolomite of what is  
believed to be the upper part of the Nelway formation.  
From 1948 to 1950, 19 tons of galena-rich nodules were  
shipped to Trail with grades of 25% lead, 2.4% zinc, and  
2.0 oz. silver/ton. Since 1950, no major underground  
programs have been undertaken. The company's review of  
known mineralization indicates a possible extension  
plunging steeply in a SW direction over the U.S. border.

Hawkwe plans to complete a program of geological  
mapping, backhoe trenching, sampling and diamond  
drilling by 31Jan90. About \$100,000 has been budgeted  
for the program with funding to be provided by NIM and  
Company Ltd. Partnership - 1989 to acquire 181,818  
shares at 55¢ each for total proceeds of \$100,000.

Production from the nearby Salmo lead/zinc area  
exceeds 30,000,000 tons with silver grading 0.8 oz./ton,  
3% lead, 5% zinc, cadmium and germanium. Significant  
high grade sections of 25% lead and zinc were obtained  
from the major producers.
