HISWAY RESOURCES CORP. (HIS-V)

FURTHER EXPLORATION RECOMMENDED -G.Ronald Webb, President of Hisway Resources Corp. has reported exploration on the Quatse Lake property 8 km southwest of Port Hardy, Vancouver Island, B.C. has included selected sample taken from the Caledonia ore dump contained 25.42% copper, 4.27% zinc, and 77.33 oz. silver per ton.

Mineralization at the Hill 160 North showing consists of bornite and chalcopyrite along a surface showing of approximately 500 feet in length and narrowing gradually from 5 feet to a few inches in width. A 2 meter chip sample collected by Dr. Christopher, from this area contained 2.81% copper and 10.6 ppm silver. A select sample from Hill 160 showing contained 2.46% copper and 8.0 ppm silver.

Drill hole Q89-1 cut pyrite and minor chalcopyrite, with bornite in epidote-quartz vesicles at the bottom where a 1 meter intersection assayed at 0.36% copper.

Dr. Christopher states: "The Property contains a large area with excellent potential for high grade, precious metal enhanced, copper-lead-zinc skarn deposits and bulk tonnage deposits of the Island Copper type".

A \$500,000 exploration program has been recommended.
