TSA EXPLORATIONS LTD. (TSU-V)

PROGRAM COMPLETED—John K. Campbell, president, reports TSA Explorations Ltd. and TECK CORP. have completed an exploration program on the lead/zinc Grizzly property located 90 km east of Quesnel, in the Cariboo district of central B.C. Teck, the operator, is earning a 52% interest by spending \$100,000 on exploration. (SEE GCNL No. 218, 14Nov89, P.2 FOR EARLIER DETAILS)

During Nov/89, a three-week program saw 19 trenches and a number of pits excavated and sampled. Lead/zinc showings over an area one km by two km were reported by Robert Mickle, prospector. Heavy snow impeded the work; however, one zone was traced over 300 meters with widths varying from four to 12 meters. An estimate of average grade in this zone would be about 6% - 7% combined lead/zinc. Further work recommended includes an extensive mapping and rock sampling program over the entire property along with further trenching and sampling to extend the exposed areas. If results are favourable, a drilling program will be undertaken.
