CHUCHI LAKE DRILL RESULTS - Norman Yeo, Director,
reports Digger Resources c.
will proceed with a \$1,700,000 exploration program in
summer 1990 on the Chuchi Lake project 30 km west of Mt.
Milligan, 150 miles north of Prince George, B.C. The
project is a 50/50 joint venture with BP Resources
Canada. The 1989 drill holes completed on the
gold/copper anomaly, which measures 3,300 by 5,000 feet,
returned the values listed above. The 1990 work program
is designed to define the extent of the known
mineralization and investigate two other copper and gold
anomalies on the property. Depending on results, a
further program over the 1990/91 winter season will be
considered. Funds have been allocated to allow
exploration on newly optioned ground adjacent to the
Chuchi claims. Some 13,000 feet of drilling is planned
for next summer and 60 line kilometers each of
geophysical and geochemical surveys will be run on the
two anomalies. The second stage of the program will
include an additional 33,000 feet of drilling. It is
expected 70 to 80 holes will be completed between next
June and October. Digger has been approached by one
major mining company with a view to funding the program
through private placements. News of funding
arrangement is expected within three weeks. (SEE GCNL
