<u>The Gully zone</u> comprises massive chalcopyrite, pyrhotite and pyrite exposed over 75 meters long and up to 3.6 meters wide that has been traced by soil geochemistry and geophysical surveys for 800 meters. A drilling program is planned for this target. At the <u>Heel zone</u>, a large gold/silver/base metal anomaly was found in soil and rocks that will require extensive trenching in 1990 prior to drilling. Other gold-bearing zones within the Rek claims require follow-up. Initial reconnaissance work has yet to be carried out on about 2/3 of the property.
