VALULT ASSAYS REPORTED - Maurice Hamelin, president of  
Seven Mile High Resources Inc.  
reported on the first 9 holes of the current program on  
the Vault claims near Okanagan Falls, B.C. The project  
is an Inco Gold 60%, Seven Mile High 40% joint venture.  
These 9 holes were reconnaissance holes drilled in the  
West and North zones; No.82701 was abandoned and  
No.82702 to No.82707 showed weak or narrow  
mineralization. The North vein has now been traced on  
surface over 3,000 feet. A second drill has been  
brought to the property to drill 30 to 36 holes on this
