HAWKEYE DEVELOPMENTS LTD. (HAD-V)

GRAB SAMPLES RETURN - Joe Whipple, president, Hawkeye
HIGH GRADE ASSAYS Developments Ltd. reports a grab
sample of pyrrhotite and quartz
mineralization from the Rand vein on the Erie Creek
claims, about 6 miles west of Salmo, B.C., has returned
6.97 oz.gold/ton, 1.11 oz.silver/t. The material sampled
was weathered and further sampling to confirm these and
other values in wall rock and vein material ranging from
0.002 to 2.76 oz.gold/t is required. Hawkeye has the
rights to a 100% interest, subject to various net smelter
returns. The area has extensive skarn type mineraliza-
tion in addition to the known vein deposits. A field
crew is presently preparing a grid for geophysical,
geochemical and geological surveys, and drilling and
blasting work to sample unweathered rock is in progress.
The 5 sq. mile property includes the Second Relief mine
that produced 100,000 oz. gold between 1925 and 1941.
