Black Swan also reported the start of a 5,000 foot diamond drilling program on the TAS property, 140 miles north of Prince George, B.C. Black Swan, the operator, can earn a 55% working interest from Goldcap Inc. and Noranda in the property by expenditure of \$800,000 on exploration.

The current drill program has been designed to test continuity of gold/copper mineralization in 5 high-grade sulhide zones identified by earlier drilling programs. Exploration results to date suggest that the copper/gold mineralization is localized in an altered zone adjacent to, or possibly overlying an intrusive stock.

Significant results from each of the 5 zones tested during the 1988 diamond drilling program are as follows:
