MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE - Teeshin Resources Ltd., 66  
ACCEPTS FEASIBILITY STUDY 2/3%, reported that the Dome  
Mountain joint venture with  
Canadian-United Minerals Inc. 33 1/3%, has held the first  
Management Committee meeting, which accepted the Dome  
Mountain feasibility study and approved the capital bud-  
get for construction of the mill and other facilities at  
the Dome Mountain project about 25 miles east of  
Smithers, B.C.

Approval was also given to a \$300,000 exploration  
budget for 6,000 feet of diamond drilling to test 3 new  
anomalies and one mineralized outcrop area, further I.P.  
surveys and surface mapping. This program is to start  
immediately and is aimed at expanding reserves beyond the  
300,000 tons grading 0.355 oz.gold/t, 2.34 oz.silver/t.

The companies are discussing project funding with  
financial institutions and expect to obtain a commitment  
that will enable construction to start this fall.  
Development plans forecast average annual production of  
34,000 ounces of gold and 95,000 ounces of silver.
