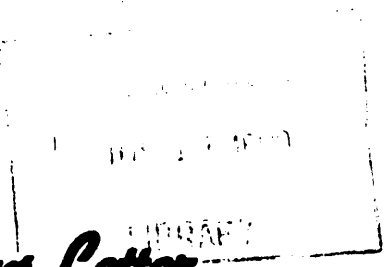

The current program of work has enhanced the reserve potential of the Polaris-Taku mine. An updated reserve calculation is now being completed and a comprehensive program of reserve development is being planned.
