significant anomaly on Blair Mountain, 13 km east of Wells, B.C., which is indicative of a possible lode deposit. The company has acquire by staking 40 units of mineral claims comprising the area of this anomaly.

Assay results from a test hole in an area shown as a significant anomaly by infra-red photoprgraphy are reported above. Assays have also been conducted at various depths on 4 further test holes, in the same anomaly area, circling the original hole at a distance of some 1 km.

The company is presently having the results of the infra-red photography and the pattern indicated from the test holes analyzed by its geologist.
