

GIGI RESOURCES LTD. (GIG-V)

FIELD CREWS MOBILIZED - Arthur Clemiss, chairman of Gigi
TROPHY GOLD PROJECT Resources Ltd. reports field
crews will be mobilized in June
to begin the 1989 exploration program on the 71 sq. mile
Trophy gold project, Galore Creek area, 105 miles NW of
Stewart, B.C. Gigi Resources can earn a 55% interest by
the staged issuance of 200,000 shares to CONTINENTAL
GOLD CORPORATION (CNT-V;CNTVF-NASDAQ) and by spending
\$5,500,000 on exploration over 5 years.

Exploration in 1987-88 by Continental resulted in
the discovery of 23 gold and silver bearing mineralized
zones. SNIP-style, shear hosted veins and chalcopryrite-
magnetite-gold bearing skarns are among several types of
mineralization found on the property. Best intersection
from a 9,295 feet of drilling in 1988 was 0.16 oz.gold/t,
0.88 oz. silver/t over 36.4 feet from the Ptarmigan zone.

The Gigi program will consist of geochemical sampl-
ing, trenching, geological mapping and prospecting.
Drilling will be conducted on the Ptarmigan zone and
other showings developed by the exploration program.
