BRETT CLAIMS RESULTS - Stirling D. McIlveen, president, Huntington Resources reports assays from the Phase II diamond drill on the Brett claims 25 km west of Vernon, B.C. which tested two separate mineralized areas; see table above. The project is a joint venture between Huntington (49%) and CORONA CORPORATION (51%). Drill hole 89-99 targeted the untested the down-dip projection of the mineralized zone intersected in hole 89-91 and 89-92. Drilling cut a steeply west-dipping gold mineralized breccia zone 100 feet down dip of the intersection in hole 89-91 (9.3 ft of 0.726 oz.gold/t). Gold was cut in several breccia zones above the main structure. The results suggest mineralization is open down dip to the west. Gold values have been cut over a 210 ft. strike length.

Both 89-100 and 89-101 tested the area between sections 10+76N and 11+27 along the Main Shear zone where Phase I drilling returned 5.1 ft. of 0.216 oz.gold/t. This phase encountered several lower grade gold intersections within highly-altered hanging wall volcanics and footwall tuffaceous rocks. Defining the higher grade zones will require close-spaced drilling. Hole 89-102 targeted the area between the New Discovery zone and the East zone (situated several hundred meters east of the Main Shear zone) where it encountered weak gold values within highly-altered volcanic rocks near several structural features. Hole 89-103 tested an area 235 feet north of 89-102. Visible gold was encountered in altered and brecciated volcanic rocks in the footwall area of a fault zone. Both the New Discovery and East zones are open in all directions. Further drilling is required. (SEE GCNL 154, 11Aug89, P.2 FOR PHASE I EXPLORATION RESULTS).
