RIVER JORDAN ASSAYS - Maxwell H. Guthrie, president,
reports First Standard Mining Ltd.
has received assay results from the recent exploration
program on the 100%-owned River Jordan polymetallic
property located 12 miles NW of Revelstoke, B.C.
Resampling of the No. 1 zone returned average values of
8.5% zinc, 8.2% lead and 2.1 oz.silver/ton from 18
samples, representing an increase of 66% for zinc, 62%
for lead and 52% for silver over earlier sampling in the
zone. The previous work, conducted in 1961, led to a
reserve estimation of 2,872,700 tons grading 5.1% lead,
5.6% zinc and 1.1 oz.silver/t, using a 10% dilution
factor. At the mouth of the glacier that covers most of
the No. 1 zone, seven assays of massive sulphide float
averaged 6.2% zinc, 10% lead and 2.0 oz.silver/t.

R.J.Graham, First Standard's consultant, recommends
a major exploration program comprising 4 miles of
electromagnetic surveying and a minimum of 6,000 feet of
BQ diamond drilling at a cost of \$500,000.

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
