ASSAYS RECEIVED - Glen E. White, P.Eng., president of Liberty Gold Corp., reports assays have been received from the 100%-owned Tim claims in the Lac La Hache area, 70 km east of Williams Lake, B.C. A new showing discovered in the SW portion of the claims returned 2% copper and 0.50 oz.silver/ton over 5.0 feet. Geochemical results reveal an extensive gold/copper zone with over 350 parts per billion gold and 2,000 parts per million copper. An induced polarization program is underway to outline a major sulphide zone.

Three sample pits 1,000 meters apart on a large chargeability anomaly yielded 1.0 meters grading 2.15% copper and 0.01 oz.gold/ton; 1.3 meters grading 0.23% copper and 0.032 oz.gold/t and two close trenches (M & N) 1.6 meters grading 1.69% copper and 0.076 oz.gold/t and 1.9 meters grading 1.15% copper and 0.026 oz.gold /t.

A hole drilled in 1983 near the M trench hit a high grade seam at a steep angle of 140 feet grading 2.91% copper, 0.79 oz.silver/t and 0.02 oz.gold/t. Several major companies have expressed interest in the Liberty project. Liberty Gold plans a large diamond drilling program in early spring 1990.
