TRENCHING COMPLETED - James B. Wensveen, director,
reports Southern Cross Gold Inc.
has completed preliminary trenching of the
silver/copper/arsenic soil anomalies on the Mineral Hill
property 14 km north of Houston, B.C. The company can
earn a 100% interest by paying \$100,000, issuing
100,000 shares and spending about \$70,000 on exploration
over four years, subject to a 5% net smelter royalty.

Trenching results show the main anomaly outlined a
major alteration zone that contains minor sulphide
mineralization. Trenching in the area of the second
anomaly exposed a series of quartz-rich mineralized
zones striking N 25°W. Mineralization occurs across
widths of approximately 30 meters. The widest of these
zones is about two meters and contains chalcopyrite and
pyrite. Assays will be available in a few days. (SEE
