SULTANA PROPERTY ASSAYS - John H. Harper, director, reports Key Largo Resources Ltd. has received assay results from a stripping and drifting program on the Sultana property 45 km NW of Smithers, B.C. Key Largo holds a 100% interest in four claims of the Sultana group and an option to earn a 100% interest in a fifth claim by paying \$6,000 to Van Silver Holdings Ltd. and \$500,000 over 20 years against a 3% net smelter return. Van Silver also gets a 1% NSR after the \$500,000 is paid out.
