TREATY CREEK DRILLING REVIEWED - Teuton Resources Corp. has reported progress from Tantalus Resources on the Treaty Creek Project 50 miles NW of Stewart, B.C. The property is 11 miles

east of the Eskay Creek property of Calpine Resources and Stikine Resources. Tantalus can earn up to a 51% interest by making cash payments totalling \$300,000 and exploration expenditures of \$3,200,000 over five years, and issuance of 200,000 Tantalus shares to Teuton over 3 years. Drilling in the Goat Trail Zone and the Konkin Zone returned: (see table). The completed holes hit very broad widths of moderate to strongly anomalous gold mineralization. Hole TA89-5 on the Goat Trail Zone intersected six anomalous zones, the best being over a core length of 187.5 feet with values averaging 690 ppb gold.

TA89-6, a deeper test underneath TA89-5, ended in a strongly anomalous zone averaging 680 ppb gold over a core interval of 75.4 feet. Holes TA 89-7 to TA89-11 were all drilled on the Konkin Zone to follow the northeastern extension of this mineralization toward the Goat Trail Zone. TA89-7 intersected two zones averaging 505 ppb gold over 83.7 feet and 500 ppb gold over 30.2 feet, and TA89-10 averaged 656 ppb gold over 39.4 feet.
