NEW RAISE CONFIRMS VERTICAL - Newhawk Gold Mines Ltd.
CONTINUITY OF HIGH GRADE GOLD 60% and Granduc Mines
Ltd. 40% have reported
assay results from the first 130 feet of drifting on the
R-8 structure at the 1200 m level, on the Sulphurets
property, located 30 miles northeast of Stewart, B.C.

averaged 1.512 oz.gold/t and 17.16 oz.silver/t across a
true width of 8.1 feet. Drifting on R-8 is part of the
1989 exploration program. Raising and drifting are
confirming the continuous nature of the R-8 structure.
Mineralization is well defined, easy to follow and
returning consistently high precious metals values. A
crosscut from the decline at the 1150 m level has
intersected the R-8 structure 50 meters (165 ft) below
the drift, diamond drill results from the latest R-8
intersection, West Zone underground and surface drilling
will be reported shortly. Assays from 220 feet slope
length of raising on the upper extremity of R-8 between
1200m and 1250m levels averaged 0.323 oz.gold/t and
17.69 oz.silver/t across 7.6 feet. The structure is
continuous between levels. Because the raise was driven
following the footwall, the full width was not exposed
by the raise and a high grade stringer in the hanging
wall not always sampled.

The three-phase 1989 exploration program, budgeted
at over \$10,000,000 for the year has been 80% spent.
Property work will continue until Christmas holiday
suspension. A full scale production feasibility study
is scheduled to be completed early in 1990.

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
