DRILLING PROGRAM TO BEGIN - John Robertson, president,
reports Teryl Resources
Corp. (22.5%) and Reg Resources Corp. (52.5%) will begin
a drill program immediately on the Silverknife claims in
the Midway area of north-central B.C. just below the
Yukon border. Chevron Resources Corp. owns 25%. The
drill hole will test a large geophysical anomaly about
600 meters long and 150 meters wide. According to
geophysical consultants, the anomaly could be caused by
a horizontal tabular body contained within a region of
moderately high resistivities and disseminated sulphide
mineralization.

Previous drilling consisted of 13,700 feet of drilling in 49 holes resulting in drill-indicated and inferred reserves totalling 400,000 tons of silver, lead and zinc ore with an estimated in-situ value of \$100 per ton. The best assays were 29.0 oz.silver/ton and 17% lead/zinc combined over a 14-foot section.
