ASSAYS AWAITED - Dragoon Resources 50% and Greenstone 50% has reported diamond drill hole 89-03 on the McNeil project has intersected a stratabound sulfide- rich structure with significant amounts of zinc, lead and copper. Assays are awaited. The property is 22 miles south of Sullivan mine at Kimberly, B.C.

The importance of this intersection-which has a true width of 1 foot and was found at a depth of 600 feet-is that it may be at the fringe of a larger, thicker base metal deposit.

"It is not unusual for structures of this type to have thicker portions which are mineable. We are in the right environment for this to occur. If we are able to locate thicker sections, we will have a major discovery," president, Ian Park said. "Stratabound base metal deposits tend to be extensive, with large tonnages and consistent grades".

A boulder recently found near the No.89-03 drill site consisted of high grade lead sulfide with a similar appearance to Sullivan ore.

The most likely area where thickening may occur is to the north of 89-03 where a 1.5 mile long geophysical anomaly has yet to be explained. Further drilling is first planned to the south in an attempt to locate the up dip extension of the structure. Detailed geophysics is also continuing.(SEE GCNL 186, 27Sept89 for some detail).
