CHUCHI LAKE - Norman Yeo, director, reports that Digger DRILL RESULTS Resources Inc. and 50/50 joint venture partner BP Resources Canada has received encouraging assays from the Chuchi Lake property 30 km west of Mt. Milligan where Continental Gold/BP Resources are exploring 150 miles north of Prince George, B.C. The property is road-accessible. The initial three-hole drill program tested coincident IP, magnetic and copper and gold-in-soil anomalies in association with mineralized diorite to monzonite porphyry intrusion. Some unsplit intervals of core between and either side of the reported intervals above are currently being analyzed. The target area measures 5,000 by 3,300 ft. Mr. Yeo said these results warrant an extensive drill program in 1990.

Elsewhere on the property, two further copper and copper/gold anomalies require follow-up geophysical and drilling programs. On the "multi-element" anomaly, 2 km SE from the copper/gold anomaly, drill holes 89-01 to 89-06 returned low values with drill hole 89-01 returning 34 meters of 0.007 oz.gold/ton. Due to the high, and as yet unexplained, soil anomalies further work will be warranted in this area next year.

Recently, Digger and BP optioned the adjoining Goldbrick group of claims which will also be included in the 1990 work program. (SEE GCNL No. 191 FOR MORE DATA)
